



Pool Rules

Please review these pool rules:

- Please shower before entering the pool
- Please walk on deck
- Avoid pushing and rough play
- Shoes/food/drinks (including coffee) are to remain in the locker rooms
- Please dispose of gum in garbage can before entering the water
- All toys must stay on the surface or below the surface of the water
- When using the slide, please make sure the bottom is clear and enter feet first
 - When on the slide, hands should be free of toys
- Please adhere to all lifeguard requests, they are there to ensure your safety

- If a belt, PFD or lifejacket is required, please wear one –stay within arm’s reach of a parent/adult – stay in the shallow end
 - If a lifeguard sees someone struggling in the water, they will ask that an assistive device be worn for safety

Parental Supervision:

- Children 5 years and under with or without lifesaving device; must be within arm’s reach of an adult in the water
- Children 6-9 years with a lifesaving device must be supervised and within arm’s reach in the water.
- Children 6-12 years, no lifesaving device; did not pass the swim test, must be supervised and within arm’s reach in the water
- Children 6-12 years, pass the swim test, must have an adult supervision on deck.
- Children 13 years and older, may swim on their own in the pool. Those not passing the swim test will be directed to swim in the appropriate areas of the pool in accordance with their abilities

When a whistle is blown:

- Short blast: look at the lifeguard for direction
- Long blast: calmly and safely exit the water then look at the lifeguard for direction

Please Note: The Leisure Pool is maintained at 3’8 for Birthday Party rentals.

An assistive device = lifejackets, PFDs, belts, or a lifeguard approved device.
