Our Commitment to Each Other:

A visit to the YMCA of Fredericton (Y) should be an enjoyable and safe experience. We expect all members, volunteers and staff to act in accordance with our core values of Caring, Fun, Respect, Accountability and Inclusiveness. To ensure everyone's pleasant and safe experience, please:

- Scan your membership card to access the facility for each visit
- Non-members 16 years and older are required to sign in and show government picture ID when purchasing a day pass drop in for each visit.
 - Parents or guardians joining or dropping-off children (members) must also sign-in for each visit.
- Supervise all children under 12 years of age (by a guardian 16 years and older).
- Respect the Code of Conduct of the YMCA.
- Remove all outside footwear before entering the Wellness Centre, studios, and locker rooms.
- Be respectful when you are using a cell phone in the facility.
- Avoid bringing nuts; we are a nut-reduced facility.
- Use a sealed plastic container for all beverages.
- Respect the scent free policy.
- Lock all personal belongings in a locker.
- Do not use cell phones or cameras in the locker room area; cell phone use of any kind is prohibited in locker rooms.
- "Smart eyewear" (META glasses) and other devices with concealed video/photo capacity is strictly prohibited.

The Y is not responsible for damage to or destruction of property belonging to or in possession of a member nor for the loss or theft of such property.

Privacy Statement:

The YMCA is committed to protecting the personal information by following responsible information handling practices, in keeping with privacy laws. We collect and use personal data

in order to better meet your service needs, to ensure the safety of our participants, for statistical purposes, to inform you about YMCA programs or services that you are registered in, to complete payment transactions and to satisfy government and regulatory obligations. You may also hear from us periodically about other YMCA programs, services and opportunities that may interest and benefit you. We do not rent, sell or trade our mailing lists. Photography and Videos are not permitted in the facility or any off site venues without prior approval from management.

Membership Access Policy:

Membership cards are issued to all members of the Y and must be scanned at the Membership Services desk upon arrival. When setting up a membership, government-issued picture ID is required. A photo record is required at the time of joining and is retained in our computer system as a means of Identification.

The YMCA reserves the right to withdraw or limit any part of our facility for a period of time to carry out routine maintenance and events. The YMCA's swimming pools are subject to maintenance closures at minimum once annually. Members will be given advance notice and of the times and dates, and no refunds will apply. Access arrangements with other local pools will be made when possible. No refunds will be issued in the event of unforeseen maintenance issues regarding the pool.

Waiver of Liability:

Memberships, personal training consultations, and all registered programs require pre-signed waivers before participating. A liability waiver is a legal contract outlining the risks associated with an activity. Waiver(s) are signed during registration and then emailed to the participant.
